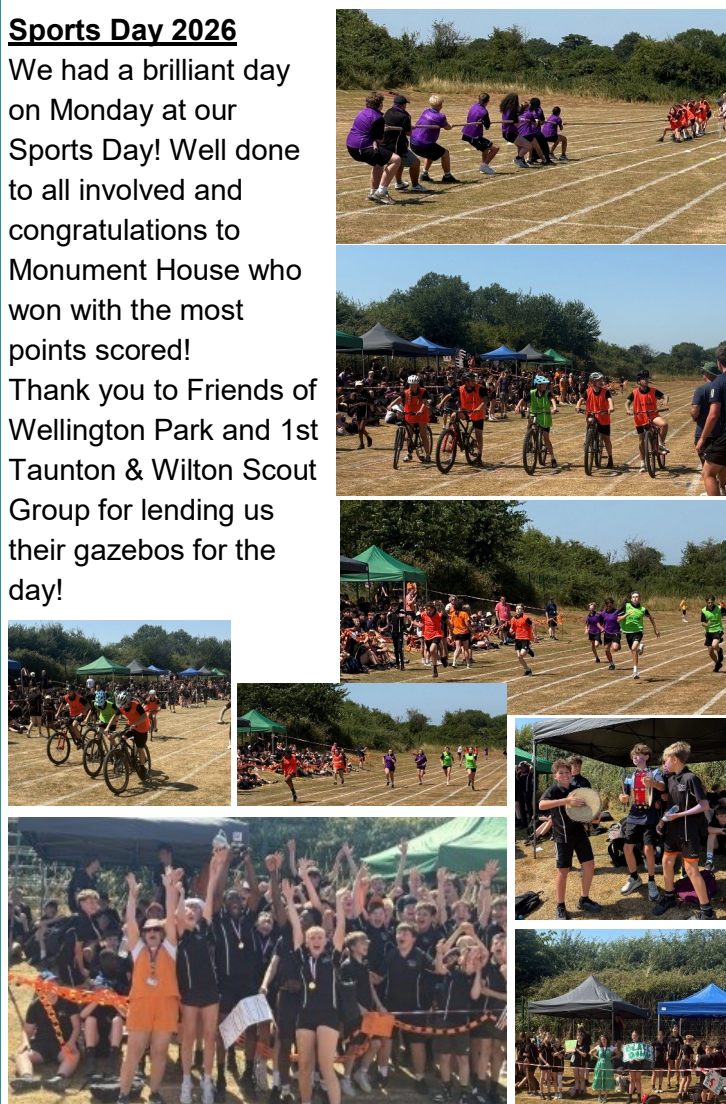
Enrichment Days

We've had a fantastic 3 Enrichment days this week! The children have enjoyed a range of activities and off-site trips. Here are just a few pictures of what they've been up to.



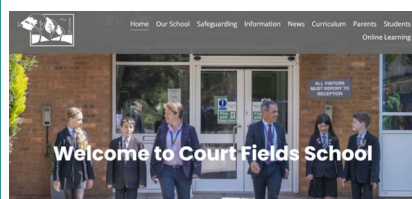
Sports Day 2026

Wellington Community Food farm visit

Following a successful visit back in the spring, a group of our Year 7 children returned to Wellington Community Food's farm, just down the road from school. What a difference a few months make!

The children supported their science lab learning about pollinators, pollination and biodiversity with plenty of hands-on activities, including observational drawing and hunting for insects.

To support our careers learning, Rose, one of the growers, talked about how the farm gets its products to its customers. The children asked questions about how the business is run, small scale sustainable farming with a local supply chain, and industrial farming/monoculture with an international supply chain. Plus, of course, we sampled the produce!
